Key projects at Western Electric's Princeton Research Center are transposed from color slides to motion pictures, through the use of this bench-top "studio," designed by John Carnevale, head of the Center's photographic team. The slides are filmed with an Arriflex 16, driven by an animation motor. Various optical effects are achieved with standard lenses and extension tubes. 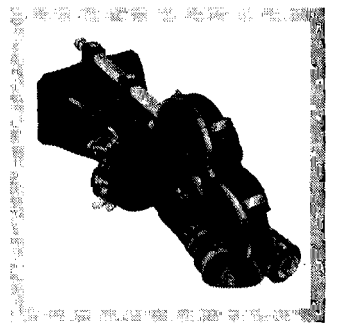
