A daylight conversion filter of the dichroic type requiring only 1/3-stop compensation has been announced by Novatech Corp., 282 Seventh Ave., New York, N.Y. 10010. Called the DY-1, the filter raises the color temperature of the company's Novatwin (*Journal*, p. 478, June 1962) when equipped with 3200 K bulbs to 6000 K to provide balanced lighting with all daylight color films. The DY-1 color filter is of the same size as the Novatwin diffusers and fits into the filter slot of the Novatwin barndoor assembly. It is priced at \$37.50.

The Anso Class I Microdensitometer has been introduced by General Aniline & Film Corp., Commercial Development Dept., Binghamton, N.Y. It is a photometric analysis system designed to sense, measure and record radiant energy and simultaneously to indicate the coordinate position. The system is a combination of a scanning and recording microdensitometer and a measuring engine. Information recording media may be in black-and-white or color. The density readings versus distance scanned is automatically plotted by a strip chart recorder and the X and Y values are presented on the reading drums.

A line of precision cells manufactured by the English optical works of Perkin-Elmer is distributed by Photovolt Corp., 1115 Broadway, New York, N.Y. 10010. The line includes more than 25 shapes made of glass, standard silica, and special far-ultraviolet and near-infrared transmitting quartz. The cells are made by a special process which eliminates bonding materials and the manufacturing tolerances are extremely narrow. The precision of the light path is reported to be within 0.01 mm. The cells fit standard spectrophotometers and are available in matched sets of 2 and 4.

A heavy duty video tape called Reeves Soundcraft Video Tape has been introduced by Reeves Soundcraft Division of Reeves Industries, Inc., Great Pasture Rd., Danbury, Conn. The new tape is produced by a process called Micro-plate which gives the tape an extremely smooth surface for intimate tape-to-head contact to reduce headwear and tape or head fouling. In field tests conducted by the firm the new tape survived more than 700 passes with no sign of deterioration.



A traveling motion-picture exhibit on a curved structure of aluminum scaffolding for presenting several films simultaneously is manufactured by Up-Right Scaffolds, 1013 Pardee St., Berkeley, Calif. The structure measures about 70 ft long on an

arc and is 20 ft high and 10 ft deep. It houses 13 projectors with an intricate arrangement of mirrors for the viewing screens. The projectionist operates the projectors from a catwalk within the covered structure and a 9-ft vertical clearance enables spectators to walk between the scaffold legs and see the interior operation. It was used for the first time at the Montreal Outdoor Exhibit.

A new beaded screen called Micro-Flect has been announced by Radiant Manufacturing Corp., 8220 N. Austin Ave., Morton Grove, Ill. In this type of screen tiny glass beads are bonded to a special double-coated plastic base to assure brightness at all viewing angles and to resist fungus and flame.
