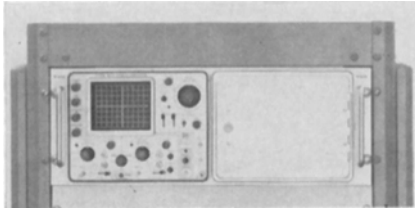

In the algebraically added mode, channel 2 can be inverted for differential operation. The Type R453 is expected to be available during the first quarter of 1966. It is priced at \$2,035.



A rack-mount oscilloscope, designed especially for testing and servicing high-speed computers, telemetering equipment, etc., where space for test instrumentation is limited, has been announced by Tektronix, Inc., P.O. Box 500, Beaverton, Ore. 97005. The unit consists of an a-c powered oscilloscope and mounting facilities including a hinged-door compartment for storing accessories. Overall dimensions are 6 $\frac{1}{8}$ in. high, 19 in. wide and 13 in. deep. The weight is about 18 lb. A 4-in. rectangular cathode-ray tube with illuminated, internal graticule, provides 8.2 sq in. of display area with bright, sharp traces even under high ambient light conditions. The unit is priced at \$1,400, with availability expected during the first quarter of 1966.



The new Ampex Videotrainer, announced by Ampex Corp., 401 Broadway, Redwood City, Calif., is a self-contained, mobile videotape recording system for use in education, training and various industrial applications. The system combines the VR-7000 Videotape Recorder with a television camera, receiver and related equipment for producing videotape programs. The Videotrainer is priced at \$5,945. The recorder alone, which weighs 78 lb, is priced at \$3,150.

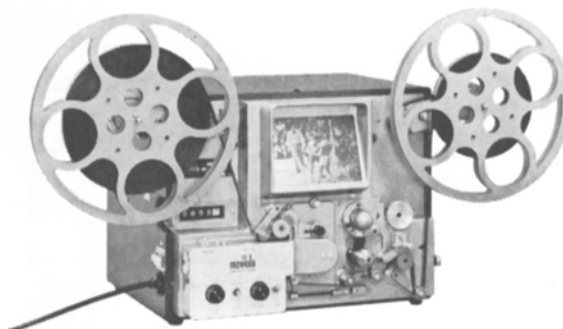
