Requirements and Deadlines

Three copies of a 500- to 750-word synopsis of the paper (up to two pages of double-spaced typewriting), giving the paper's objective and an outline of content, should be sent to SMPTE Headquarters, *Att: 102nd Conference Program*. Summaries should be received at headquarters before June 9, 1967, along with three copies of the author form and three copies of the author information sheet. The summaries will be used to prepare a 50- to 75-word abstract for the Advance Program in the Conference issue of the *Journal* (August).

Before July 7, 1967, the original and three copies of the manuscript should be sent to SMPTE Headquarters, *Att: 102nd Conference Program*. Manuscripts will be reviewed as prospects for preprinting. Authors who submit manuscripts in time for preprinting will receive 25 copies of their preprint, gratis.
