Complete manuscripts are due at SMPTE Headquarters before July 7. Authors are urged to submit manuscripts by the deadline, or before, to facilitate making preprints to be made available in time for the opening of the conference. Each author who submits his formal manuscript in time for preprinting will be sent 25 preprints, gratis.
