## Conference Program

The program for the Winter TV Conference is almost complete. The papers are listed by titles and authors, and by session, on the following pages. Program Chairman **Harold Wright** and his Program Committee of twelve, along with Arrangements Chairman **Harold Eady**, have come up with a very interesting program for the two-day Conference, comprising eighteen invited papers plus five panel discussions. The theme of this television workshop is "An Integrated Systems Approach to Color Television Broadcasting."

The following areas will be discussed by panels: "Lighting," evaluated by a group of working lighting directors. The moderator for this panel is E. Carlton Winckler. "Problems in the Application of Video-Tape Recording to Broadcasting" will be debated by a special panel of video-tape users, followed by answers to written questions from the audience. These will be answered by members of the SMPTE Video-Tape Recording Committee. Fred M. Remley is moderator. "Transmitters and Transmission" will be discussed on Saturday morning. "Receivers", a panel discussion, has Don Harrold as moderator. Finally, a "Film and Telecine" discussion will be moderated by Stanley F. Quinn, CBC, Montreal. The panelists are K. Blair Benson, D. McRae, G. Brill, L. Harrop, L. DeMarsh and D. Zwick.
