Requirements and Deadlines

Three copies of a 500- to 750-word synopsis of the paper (up to two pages of double-spaced typewriting), giving the paper's objective and an outline of content, should be sent to SMPTE Headquarters, *Att: 104th Conference Program*, 9 East 41st St., New York, N.Y. 10017. Summaries should be received at Headquarters by July 19, 1968, with three copies of the Author Form and three copies of the Author Information Sheet. The summaries will be used to prepare 50- to 75-word abstracts for the Advance Program in the Conference issue of the *Journal* (October).

By August 19, 1968, the original and three copies of the manuscript should be sent to SMPTE Headquarters, *Att: 104th Conference Program*. Manuscripts will be reviewed as prospects for preprinting. Authors who submit manuscripts in time for preprinting will receive 25 copies of their Preprint, gratis.
