The Photomec Silver Recovery Unit (SRU) has been announced by Bell & Howell Ltd., Photo Products Group, Alperston House, Bridgewater Rd., Wembley, Middlesex, England. The unit is designed to maintain the silver content of the fixing bath at the optimum level and to recover the silver in an easily removable form. Tanks from 25-gal upwards can be served either by single units or, for high-capacity plants, with a bank of SRUs running in series with one pump. The SRU is provided with quick-change cathodes from which the silver deposit can be easily released. The amount of silver recovered is directly proportional to the current applied to the recovery cell and the time during which the current passes. The complete system (Model S/A) comprises the recovery cell, circulation pump and tank, low voltage power unit, output filter, 25-micron stainless-steel mesh elements and mounting bracket. The system is also available as Model S/B comprising the recovery cell, low-voltage power unit, circulation pump, flow switch, and inlet and outlet filters of stainless-steel mesh elements. Price of the complete silver recovery units is in the region of £ 400 to £ 420. Model S/C consists of the recovery cell only and is priced at £ 185.

Two new lenses, the R7 and the Automatic Iris Zoom, have been announced by Angénieux Corp. of America, 440 Merrick Rd., Oceanside, N.Y. 11572. The R7 is an extreme wide-angle lens for 16mm motion
