The 105th Technical Conference Program Chairman *V. D. Armstrong* and his committee have completed plans for the Papers Program for the forthcoming Technical Conference in Miami Beach. Over 70 papers are scheduled for presentation in 10 Topic Sessions. Facilities for professional sound and projection will be available in the French Room of the Fontainebleau Hotel where the sessions will be held. Special sessions will be featured during the Conference in the areas of Oceanography and Aerospace.
