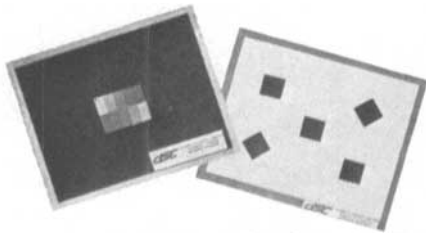


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on such subjects as air and temperature measurements, cooling power requirements, how to determine the size of the blower wheel, effects of speed changes on blower performance and other items of interest.

The Trouperette II quartz-bromine follow spotlight is described and illustrated in a data sheet available from The Strong Electric Corp., 91 City Park Ave., Toledo, OH 43601. Light data and specifications

for performance at various distances are included.

A 108-page illustrated catalog of audio-visual equipments is available from Bend's, Inc., Catalog Dept., 161 E. Grand Ave., Chicago, IL 60611, upon request on company letterhead. In addition to descriptions of equipments, the catalog contains editorial and "how-to" articles on such subjects as cameras, lamps, editing, video tape and microphones.

The X-60, 6,000-W xenon projection arc lamp is described and illustrated in a 4-page brochure available from Strong Electric Corp., 79 City Park Ave., Toledo, OH 43601. Designed for use in drive-ins and large indoor theaters, the lamp uses a bulb which burns in a horizontal position.

Box 613 Woodger Road, Shepherd's Bush, London, W.12, England. Among the equipments described are sound control console, visual aids, dimmer control and overhead and slide projectors.
