



A new 8mm movie camera called the Fujica Z-600 has been introduced by the Fuji Photo Film Co. of Japan. It is distributed in the United States by Ehrenreich Photo-Optical Industries, Inc., Garden City, NY 11530. Features include an electrically-powered $f/1.8$ reflex zoom lens (11 components, 14 elements) with a $6\times$ range from 8 to 48mm. The CdS cell of the electric eye circuit is built into the reflex optical system behind the diaphragm. A servo-motor opens or closes the diaphragm blades in inverse proportion to the amount of light reaching the film. The footage counter is calibrated in both meters and feet and the counter registers the number of frames exposed by means of a large needle that rotates during shooting. The camera is $8\frac{1}{2}$ in high, $7\frac{1}{4}$ in deep and $2\frac{3}{8}$ in thick. It weighs 2 lb, 15 oz. The price is \$329.50.
