

# SMPTE Winter Television Conference Atlanta, GA

This year's Winter Television Conference is set for January 30-31 at the Marriott Motor Hotel, Atlanta. Program Chairman **Hugo A. Bondy**, WAGA-TV, Atlanta, announced that the theme of the Conference will be "practicality." "The authors of all papers and participants in panel discussions will be requested to make their presentations in the terms of practical applications." Arrangements Chairman for the Conference is **Charles Cannon**, Southern Film Lab., Inc., Atlanta. Assisting Mr. Bondy as Associated Program Chairmen are **Marshall Kooksey**, Atlanta Cine Labs, Atlanta, and **Joseph P. Mingioli**, National Medical Audio-Visual Center, Atlanta. Hotel information and reservation forms will be mailed out to the membership in December. A large group of rooms in the Marriott Motel have been set aside until January 1, 1970.

Two panel discussions will be held during the course of the Conference: *Film Problems* will deal with the practical problems that arise between the broadcasters, film producers, the distributor and the agency. *Video-Tape Recorders* will go into the general problems relating to their use and operation. Audience participation will be encouraged for both panel discussions on a "no holds barred" basis.

Other subjects to be covered on the Conference Program are: (1) report on work being done to up-grade television industry standards, to provide reference information along the networks to re-establish original burst phase and chroma levels; (2) station/network/AT&T/local telephone company relations; (3) CATV system/station relationships; (4) educational television, its practical applications in the classroom; (5) video-tape recorder velocity-error compensation; and (6) future developments.

In addition it is hoped that a presentation will be available covering the communications system used in Apollo 11, as well as other subjects still in the planning stages.

## Call for Papers

Two copies of a 500- to 750-word synopsis of the paper (two-pages of double-spaced typewriting), giving the paper's objective and summary of its content should be sent to SMPTE Headquarters, *ATT: Winter TV Conference*, 9 East 41st St., New York, NY 10017, by November 3, 1969. They should accompany two copies of the Author Form and Author Information Sheet.

By December 12, 1969, the original and three copies of the manuscript should be sent to SMPTE Headquarters, *ATT: Winter TV Conference*. Manuscripts will be reviewed as prospects for preprinting. Authors who submit papers in time for preprinting will receive 25 copies of their preprint, gratis.
