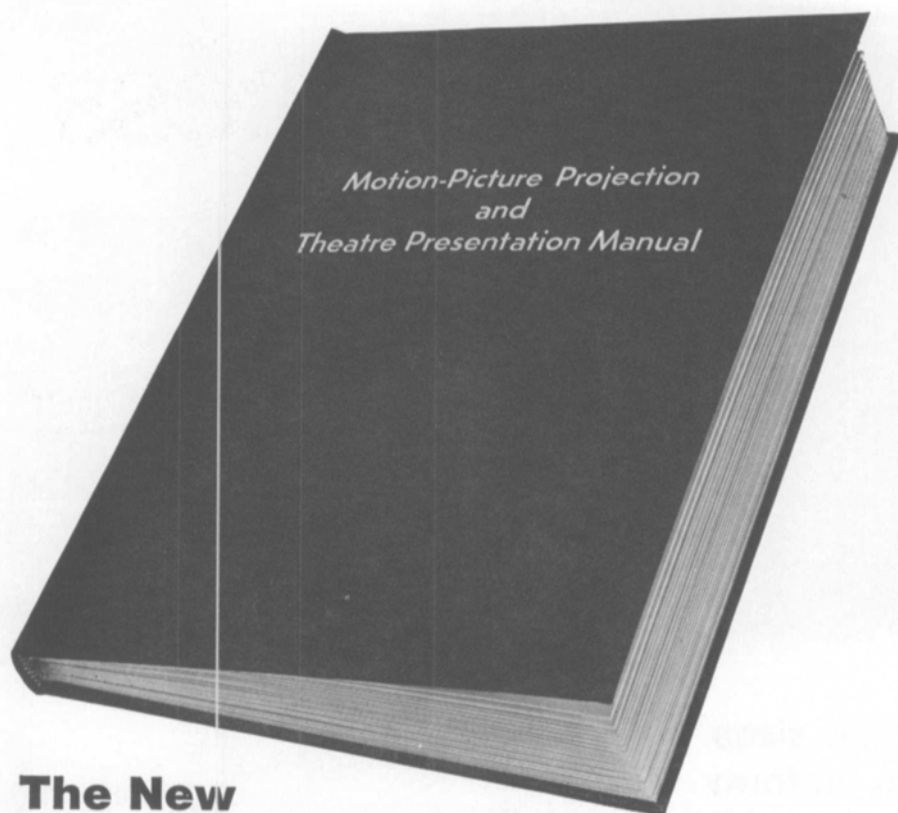

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Biographical Note

Paul W. Fassnacht

Paul W. Fassnacht retired in February as President and Chief Executive Officer of Technicolor, Inc. He continues with the company as a member of the Board of Directors and as a consultant.



Mr. Fassnacht was born in Philadelphia on November 29, 1905. He joined Technicolor in Boston in 1929 as a process control specialist and in 1931 he transferred to the Hollywood plant as a film technician in the control department. In 1944 he was promoted to Plant Superintendent and in 1956 he was made Plant Manager.

He was appointed Vice-President of Production of the Motion Picture Division in 1961 and Vice-President of International Operations in July 1964. In 1965 he was made General Manager of the Motion Picture and Television Divisions and Director of Systems Research. He was elected President of Technicolor in January 1966 and later that year he was elected Chief Executive Officer. He was elected a member of the Board of Directors in 1965 and he also served on the Executive and Finance Committees of the Board. He was also Managing Director and a member of the Board of Directors of Technicolor S.p.A., Rome; Chairman of the Executive Committee and Chairman of the Board of Directors of Technicolor Ltd., London; and Managing Director and a member of the Board of Directors of Technicolor Fotografica, S. A., Barcelona, Spain.

His long and successful career is the more remarkable in that he was largely self-educated. Between 1938 and 1956 he attended various scientific and management courses at the University of California, Los Angeles.

Among other honors he received a Scientific Award from the Academy of Motion Picture Arts and Sciences in 1959. In 1967 he received a Special Citation at the American Television Commercial Festival for Technical Achievement for Technicolor's Vidronics process.

Mr. Fassnacht has been a member of the Society since 1955. He was made a Fellow in 1967. He is a member of the Academy of Motion Picture Arts and Sciences and the National Academy of Television Arts and Sciences.
