

1973 Winter Television Conference

January 19–20, Key Biscayne, Florida

The 1973 Winter Television Conference will be held this winter at the Sonesta Beach Hotel, Key Biscayne, Florida on January 19 and 20. The Hotel itself has 300 spacious rooms, some with balconies.

Program Co-chairmen, **Stanley Colbert** of Edutronics, and **James D. Caron** of Capital Film Labs have compiled a program of extremely timely technical papers for the two-day meeting. The papers will be presented in four sessions, although the possibility of additional ones arriving after December press time may necessitate adding one more session, Friday night.

Registration rates for the Conference are \$30.00 for SMPTE Members and \$40.00 for nonmembers. There will be a luncheon on both days of the Conference, each with an important guest speaker to be announced later. Each luncheon will cost \$6.00. Package registrations are available which will include registrations and both luncheons: for members, \$40.00; and nonmembers, \$50.00. The Friday morning session opens with a film, *Kite Flying*. After this session, there will be a luncheon at the hotel, and attendees will be transported to Miami-Dade Junior College for the afternoon session. The film, *Destination the Beach* will open the afternoon session, after which there will be a tour of the facilities of Miami-Dade's Audio Visual Department. Saturday's morning session begins with the film *Serpent's Gift*, which is followed by the session itself and then another luncheon at the hotel. Throughout the entire Conference, the Kodak Videofilm Express will be on exhibit.
