## Chairmen Named

sibility for all non-program activities and services. He will be assisted by a group of subcommittee chairmen who will be listed in a future issue of the *Journal*.

Teitelbaum also announced the appointment of **Dom Capano**, Cinecraft International, Inc., as Exhibit Chairman. Information on the exhibit will be available soon, Capano said. Because the Americana is a new hotel for the Society, he and his committee are studying several exhibit area layouts to determine what would be the best for SMPTE's needs.

## Call for Papers

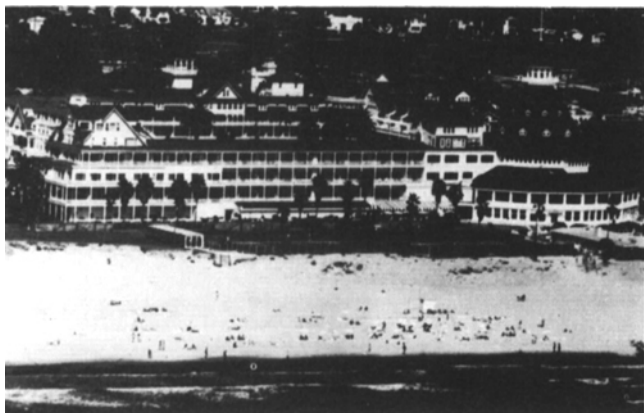

Pointer said the deadline for author submission of Author forms and a 500–750 word synopsis of the paper, is August 6, so at this point there is plenty of time to decide if a paper can be made ready for the Conference in October. The manuscript is due at SMPTE Headquarters by September 21.
