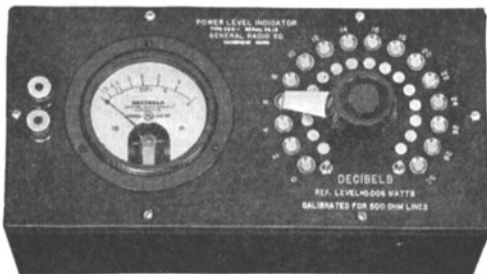


## TYPE 586-C POWER LEVEL INDICATOR

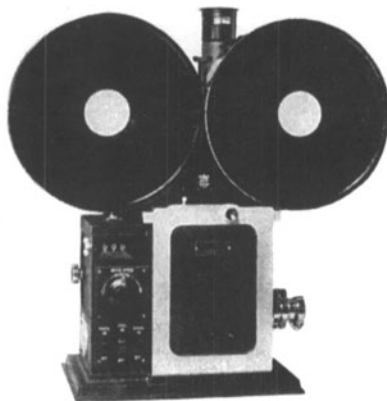
