Mr. L. B. Cornwell described a permanent-magnet loud speaker, placing special emphasis on the development of a single-diaphragm type of speaker having a linear reproduction and low average harmonic.

Mr. J. M. Blaney described the development and construction of a new 16-mm. high-speed continuous developing machine incorporating several novel means of film propulsion.
