JOSEPH H. McNABB, president and chairman of the Board of the Bell and Howell Company, died on January 5, 1949, in Chicago. Mr. McNabb was born in Canada, and received his technical education at the Collegiate Institute, St. Thomas, Ontario. He joined Bell and Howell in 1916, and in 1922, he was made chairman of the Board.

Mr. McNabb is well remembered for his activities in the professional and amateur motion picture fields, as an organizer and executive, and for his contributions to the war effort, particularly in the field of optics. He was a Fellow of the Society of Motion Picture Engineers.
