The Robot II Splicer is shown in the currently available Mark IV 35mm model. Developed in England by Gustav Jirouch, it is marketed in England by Cine Television Equipment Ltd., and is distributed in the United States by Hollywood Film Co., 5446 Carlton Way, Hollywood 27, Calif. Designed to be a very fast and fully automatic splicer, its splice width is given as 0.077 in. Its dimensions are $7\frac{1}{2} \times$

$8\frac{1}{2} \times 6\frac{1}{2}$ in. and it weighs 38 lb. The price is \$650.00, delivered. Particular advantages claimed for it are: equal scraping of emulsion down to the base and removing the emulsion in one piece, thus minimizing dirt and dust; straight and square end cutting; elimination of any special soundtrack blooping; and making double or treble joins without loss of material.
