

# SMPTE Advanced Television and Electronic Imaging Conference February 4-5, 1994 Chicago Downtown Marriott, Chicago, Illinois

The SMPTE Advanced Television and Electronic Imaging Conference, entitled "Unveiling New Technologies and Applications," will take place February 4 to 5, 1994, at the Chicago Downtown Marriott.

The two-day conference will be preceded by an all-day tutorial on February 3, entitled "Compression: Expectations and Realities."

## Papers Program

The papers program is being organized by Program Chairmen Steve Robinson, Serial Scene, and Jim Pianowski, Sony. Don Adydan, Post

Effects, is the General Arrangements Chairman.

The two-day papers program will address pertinent topics in the motion imaging arena. Technical papers presented at the conference will cover such technologies as computer imaging, display advancements, production and post-production developments, medical applications, fiber optics, digital and advanced television, digital television terrestrial broadcasting (DTTB), and print media association.

The event will be broken down into several topics: Acquisition and Conversion for Resolution Independence, Manipulation of High-

Resolution Data, Advanced Transmission and Distribution Systems, Compression: Expectations and Realities, High-Density Storage, and Testing in the Digital Production/Post-Production Environment. In addition there will be discussions with users involved in pilot projects applying the technologies covered in the conference program.

Papers that are presented at the conference will be compiled and published in a book that will be sold at the conference.

Updated information will continue to be published in the *Journal*.
