### Call for Papers

## The 1994 European SMPTE Conference September 22-24, 1994, Cologne, Germany Conference Theme: "Convergence of Imaging Media"

Based on the success of the first European SMPTE conference held in Cologne in 1992, the next European conference, to be held in 1994, will be one of Europe's leading forums for the dissemination of new technical information in television, electronic imaging, and related fields. The conference will be held again during the Photokina Fair in Cologne. The date, falling just two days after the IBC in Amsterdam, will provide an excellent opportunity for international experts to participate.

The technical sessions will be preceded by one day of tutorials, which should help to create a better understanding between people working in television and those working in computer imaging. The theme of the tutorials will be "TV Imaging and Computer Imaging — How to Speak Together." You are invited to submit a paper to SMPTE for presentation at this conference (technical sessions and tutorials). Forms are available from headquarters.

Please note the following schedule:

• **By April 15, 1994:** Name of author(s), address, title of paper, etc.,

should be submitted on the author form. A 500-word synopsis outlining the content of the proposed paper should be submitted on the synopsis forms. The author information sheet should also be submitted by that date. Early submission is recommended. Fax copies of these forms will be accepted.

• **By July 14, 1994:** Three copies and one original of your manuscript must be received for publication in the conference proceedings. You will be notified of paper acceptance by May 22, at which time instructions on how to prepare your manuscript will be provided. Fax copies of the manuscript will not be accepted.
