



### Associate Member

To be eligible for this grade of membership an individual must be at least 18 years of age and interested in the study of the technical and engineering aspects of motion pictures, television, or related arts and sciences. The application must be supported by a member's recommendation or by the recommendation of two individuals from within the motion-picture or television industries.

Associate Members may vote in Section elections but cannot hold office. They may serve on any committee of the Society as members (but not as chairmen) and may vote on any matter before the committee.
