The Television Recording and Reproduction Technology Committee (V16) has formed a working group on a one-half-inch component video digital recording format. This group will be chaired by Koichi Sadashige.

The group (V16.01) will prepare all standards documentation for the recording parameters, including, but not limited to, audio, video input and output interface, data format, and tape records for both 525 line/59.94 field and 625 line/50 field television formats.


Membership is open to those who have affirmed in writing that they are directly and/or materially affected and are willing and able to participate actively in the work.
