Even as the Society is gearing up for this year's technical conference, work is already happening behind the scenes for next year's winter event. The 32nd SMPTE Advanced Motion Imaging Conference will take place in Toronto, February 5 to 7, 1998.

All-Day Seminar

The conference will include a comprehensive all-day seminar on Saturday, February 7, entitled "The Multimedia Experience." The seminar is designed to provide a sense of relevance to the technologies and issues explored at the conference.

Call for Papers

Program Chair Peter Laidlaw, Imagineering, Ltd., has announced that the conference theme will be a continuance of developments in storage and manipulation of digital imaging. Four technical sessions are planned.

The first session, on Thursday morning, February 5, will be devoted to digital disk technology, and it will examine the technical and production aspects of new disk formats. There will be a special emphasis on DVD, which is expected to have a significant impact on the way images and sound are acquired, edited, stored, and presented.

Thursday afternoon will be devoted to video networking, studying the technologies that have been developed and those that are emerging and focusing on their value and impact as they relate to users.

On Friday morning, February 6, the conference will explore "Strategies for Migrating into a DTV World." This session will deal with real issues of transitioning facilities into digital, considering the new FCC requirements, standards, and advancements in technology.

The papers sessions will conclude on Friday afternoon with an open forum panel discussion led by industry experts who will explore the technical, production, and social issues that accompany the current state of developments in the industry.

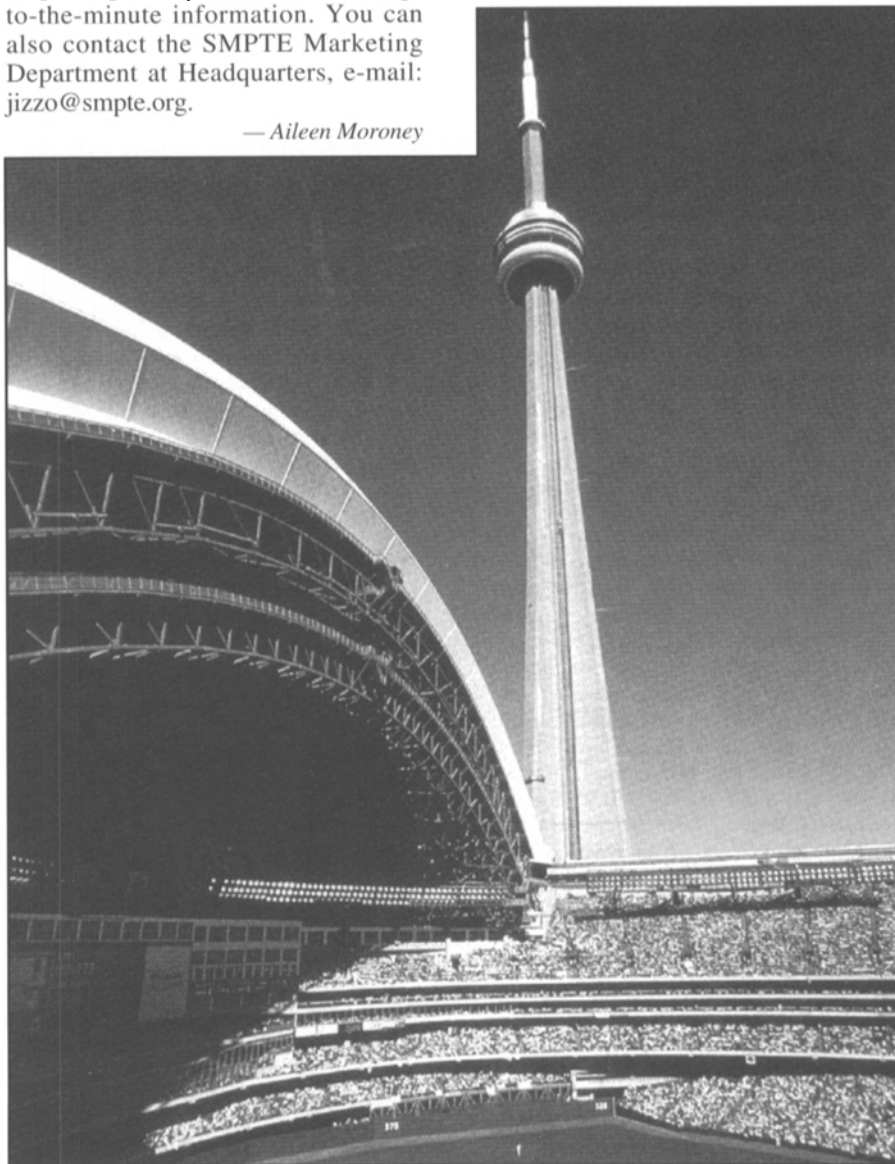
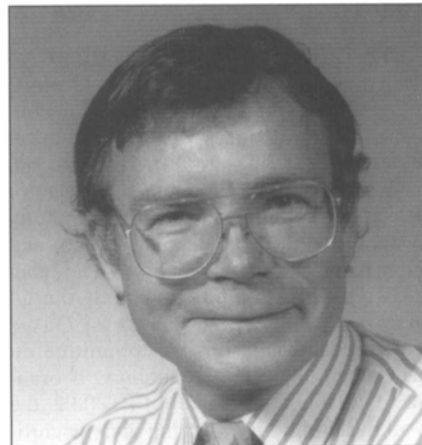
