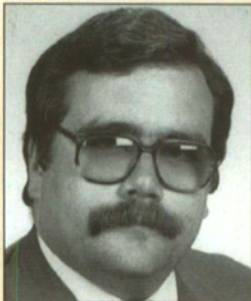

Don't forget to visit the Exhibit Hall, which features over 75 leading industry companies showcasing the latest products and services.

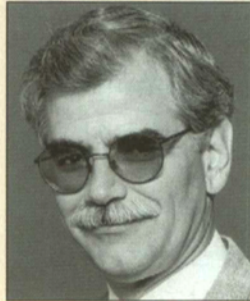

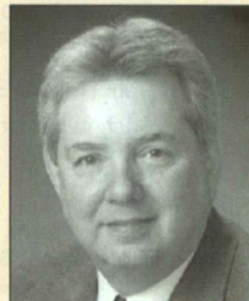

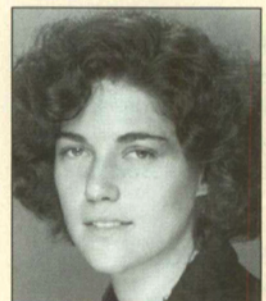
