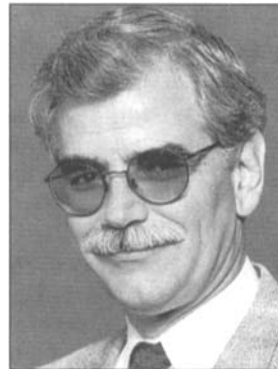


# SMPTE to Hold Fall Conference & Exhibition in New York City's Marriott Marquis Hotel November 19-22, 1999

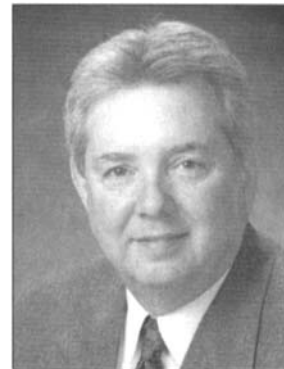
