recurrent viewing of traces while also making it easy to set up the instrument for capturing single-shot events. An auto-store mode allows the instrument to wait for an event and capture it when it occurs. A variable control for brightness of stored traces is included so a setting can usually be found for optimum trace to background contrast. Applications include vibration and shock analysis (electromechanical), ECG/EEG muscle reaction analysis (medical), machine design and service (x-ray and numerical control) as well as design of low-frequency filters and circuits for integrating and differentiating (research and education). The 1223A also includes TV sync, variable trigger holdoff, A±B modes, calibrated x-y display and selectable chop/alternate sweep operation. Power-line voltage may be set at 100, 120, 220 or 240 V (±10%) and line frequency may be from 48 to 440 Hz. The price is \$2250.

A new destaticizing blower, Model WD-100, has been announced by Wescorp, 1601 Stierlin Rd., Mountain View, CA 94040. The new blower blows ionized air at a distance of up to 7½ ft. The cone of ionized air, 4 ft in diameter at its widest point eliminates static electricity from the air surrounding a work area. Applications include graphic arts, film processing and other industries where static electricity can cause safety or quality control problems. Features include a tubular housing, instead of rectangular, to improve air flow from a fan that blows ionized air from a high-voltage electrostatic field. The fan is 5 in in diameter and provides an airflow of 150 ft³/min. The instrument operates on 115 V ac. The price is \$244.
