

SMPTE Scholarships and Grants for 1980 – 1981

Amount of Grants

Grants will be available under the new scholarship program of the Society of Motion Picture and Television Engineers for the academic year 1980 – 1981. These grants will be for either undergraduate or graduate students in engineering or the sciences related to motion pictures and television. Applicants may apply for any amount up to \$3,250, and the funds may be granted as scholarships for tuition, fees, and/or living expenses, or as "grants-in-aid" to assist in funding graduate research.

Qualified applicants will also be considered for grants related to motion-picture engineering. These grants will be made available under the sponsorship of the Academy of Motion Picture Arts and Sciences.

Fields of Study

Applicant's interests should involve the physical sciences or engineering aspects of optics, acoustics, electronics, or chemistry as related to the fields of camera, sound, lighting, and laboratory techniques, but are not necessarily limited to the above. They may also include business management or standardization as related to these fields.

Eligibility

Application is open to all full-time students of an accredited and recognized educational institution under the following conditions:

1. Applicant must not be a dependent of any member in any grade of the Society. The individual may be a student member, but this is not a requirement.
2. Applicant must be in at least the second year of study at an accredited and recognized college, university, or approved technical institute in the United States or Canada.
3. Applicant must have at least a 3.5-point cumulative scholarship average (B+), or the equivalent.
4. Applicant must state some evidence of background and interest in the technical areas of motion pictures, television, photography, or technical production.
5. Applicant must submit evidence of need as defined by his institution or a proposal approved by the institution to develop a suitable project, procedure, or special training in the areas of item 4 above.

Documents Required with Application

1. Transcripts of college records through the last completed semester.

2. Evidence from the institution you plan to attend, indicating that you are registered or have been accepted for admission.

3. A letter from the department head or student affairs office of the institution indicating their willingness to administer the scholarship or grant, if awarded.

Deadline

The completed application with the attachments listed above must be received at the Society Headquarters by 1 January 1980 to be considered. Winners will be announced by 1 March 1980.
