Yesterday, Today, and Tomorrow — is the theme for this year's Rochester-Toronto-Montreal/Ottawa/Quebec Mini-Conference to be held in Rochester, NY on 25-27 April 1980. The conference will be hosted by the Rochester Section and centered in the spectacular home of the late George Eastman, which now houses the International Museum of Photography.

The papers to be presented will cover three main subject areas: film, the film-television interface, and television. In line with the conference theme, the views of each subject area will encompass the past, present, and foreseeable future. Specific topics will range from the beginnings of incorporated dye color negative/positive films and early videotape developments; through the emerging use of computers in movie production (Disney's *Black Hole*) and designing today's television studio; onto the technologies of the 80s — charge-coupled devices, satellite transmission, multi-image, and much more.

Hotel accommodations have been reserved at Rochester's Colony East, an easy walk from the Eastman House, and the WHEC-TV studios (site for Sunday's television papers).
