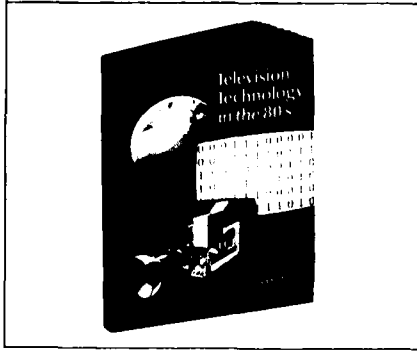
During these 65 years the Society's objectives have remained
