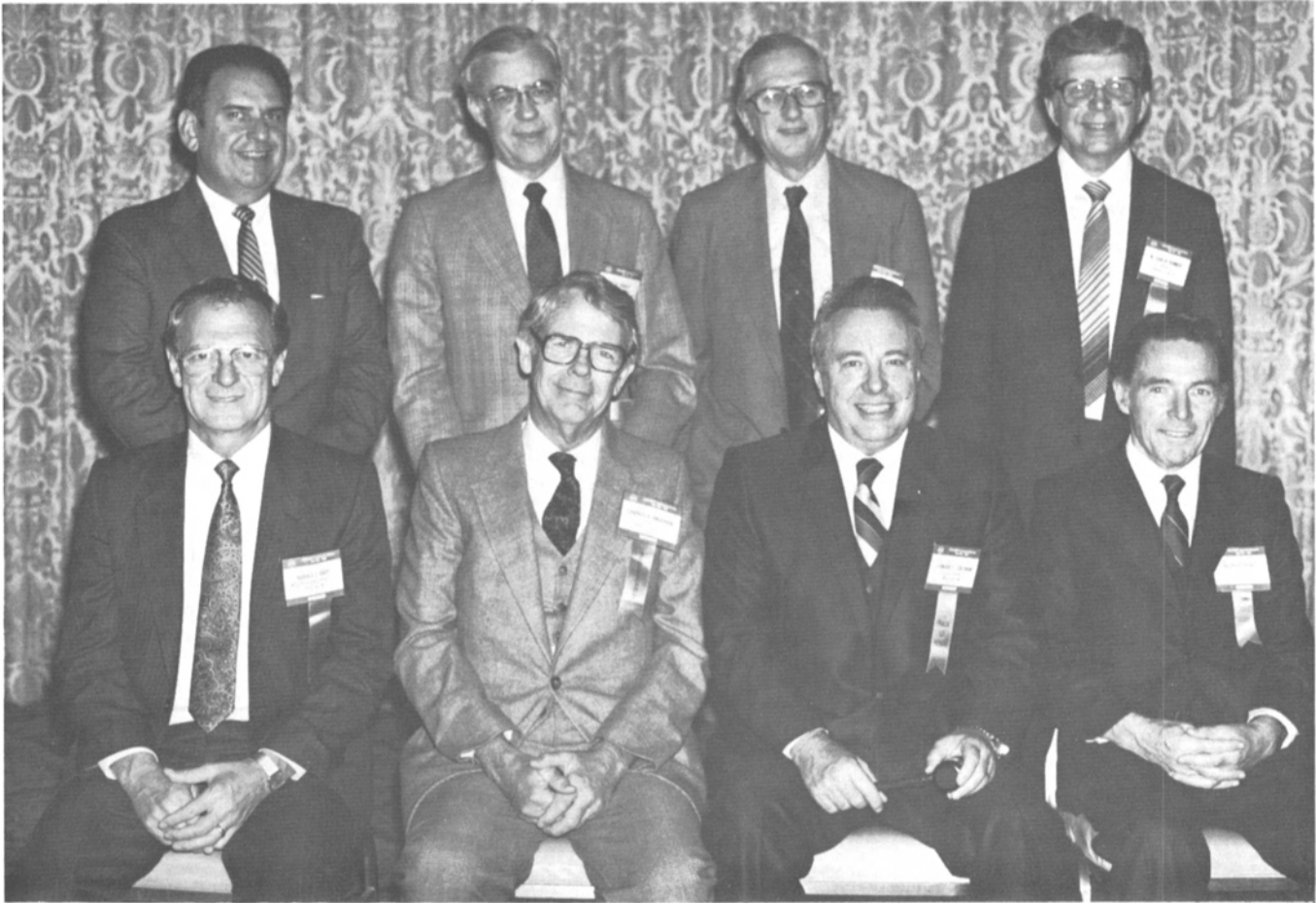


# SMPTE Holds Annual Elections; Leonard F. Coleman Elected President

Leonard F. Coleman, Eastman Kodak Co., has been elected President of the SMPTE for a two-year term beginning January, 1983. Coleman is now SMPTE Financial Vice-President. He has held a number of other SMPTE offices including Sections Vice-President and Governor. Coleman succeeds current President Charles E. Anderson, Ampex Corp., who was elected to the post of Past-President.

The results were announced at the Annual Honors and Awards Luncheon, Monday, Nov. 8 at the New York Hilton Hotel in New York City. The luncheon was held in conjunction with SMPTE's 124th Annual Technical Conference and Equipment Exhibit which was held Nov. 7-12 at the New York Hilton Hotel.

Other key SMPTE officers were elected. Harold J. Eady, Novo Com-

munications, Inc., was elected Executive Vice-President. Charles A. Ahto, Tape-Film Industries, was re-elected to a second term as Conference Vice-President. Maurice L.
