

126th SMPTE Conference to be Held October 28–November 2, 1984, in New York

The 126th Technical Conference and Equipment Exhibit will be held October 28–November 2, 1984, at the New York Hilton Hotel and the Sheraton Centre Hotel in New York City, it was announced by SMPTE Conference Vice-President Charles Ahto, Tape-Film Industries.

Because of the substantial growth of the SMPTE Exhibit, it has become necessary for the SMPTE to hold its exhibit at two hotels, as was done in 1982.

The 125th SMPTE Conference, held in Los Angeles October 30–November 4, 1983, was located in the LA Convention Center, which was able to accommodate the large number of booths the Society requires for its exhibit. Convention center facilities are not available in New York City. Although a convention center is under construction, it will not be finished in time for occupancy by the 1984 conference.
