

SMPTE Australian Section to Hold Second International Conference and Exposition June 24-27, 1986, Sydney

Plans are under way for the SMPTE Australian Section's Second International Technical Conference and Exhibit, to be held June 24-26, 1986, in Sydney, Australia. The first such meeting, *Sound & Vision '84*, held June 7-9, 1984, was an enormous success, with over 550 Australian and international delegates attending. The upcoming conference, *Sound & Vision '86*, will again be located at the spacious Sydney Showground. The technical sessions will be held at the Amatil Pavilion, and the exhibit at the Royal Hall of Industries, both within the expanse of the Showground.

The technical sessions are expected to include papers on the following topics: film production techniques; processing laboratory techniques; theatrical presentations; film-to-tape and tape-to-film transfers; videotape production and post-production; sound in film and television; computers in image production; and new technology for television. It is expected that both new techniques or products, and a review of current technology and research programs, will be covered in the presentations.
