## Books, Booklets, Brochures

**Magnetic Tape Recording**, ed. Marvin Camras, has been published by Van Nostrand Reinhold, 7625 Empire Dr., Florence, KY 41022. Camras, a Life Fellow of the SMPTE and author of over 40 publications, has compiled some of the most important papers in the history of magnetic tape recording in a single volume. The book covers new digital recording techniques and specific technical aspects of speech compression, motion-picture sound, and synthetic reverberation. Studies on high-frequency bias, magnetic tapes, magnetic heads, print-through, noise reduction (Dolby), and contact printing are among the topics included in this ambitious volume. Milestones in the history of magnetic tape recording are also chronicled; in these chapters, Smith, Poulsen, DeForest, Dolby, and other inventors recount their achievements in their own words. *Magnetic Tape Recording* contains 445 pages and is priced at \$54.50.

**Professional Video Production**, by Ingrid Wiegand, has been published by Knowledge Industry Publications, Inc., 701 Westchester Ave., White Plains, NY 10604. Written for the serious student and practicing professional, the 215-page book provides a unique, tested approach to video production. Its twelve chapters deal with the everyday technical and management concerns of the working producer, such as script preparation, budgeting, equipment requirements, staffing, and post-production. The price of the hardcover edition is \$39.95; softcover, \$24.95.

**The 1986 Wiley Science Calendar and Planning Guide**, created by John Wiley & Sons, Inc., for professionals in the computer and engineering sciences, contains dates and other useful information for over 1000 major scientific meetings and technical conventions around the world. Addresses and telephone numbers of major scientific associations, along with a record of all Nobel Prize winners in the sciences, are also included in the calendar/guide, which imitates a desk-top planner in format. The guide, priced at \$17.95, is available from John Wiley & Sons, Inc., 605 Third Ave., New York, NY 10158.
