

# 128th SMPTE Technical Conference and Equipment Exhibit

The 128th SMPTE Technical Conference and Equipment Exhibit will be held from Friday, October 24, to Wednesday, October 29, 1986. This year's site is the new Jacob K. Javits Convention Center, located on the West Side of New York City. The theme of the conference is "Today's Technology — Tomorrow's Reality?"

SMPTE Conference Vice-President Maurice L. French, Canadian Broadcasting Corp., has announced a general timetable for some of the major conference events occurring during the first few days. The registration area will open on Friday, October 24. On Friday evening, conference registrants will have the opportunity to attend a reception sponsored by Eastman Kodak Co.
