It features a ventilated metal housing with easy-to-grip ribs and a precision temperature-sensing system.

The case is lightweight, waterproof, and durable. Cables can be fed in through a side vent. Two side and two front pockets provide storage for spare tapes, batteries, radio mike, and cables.
