Calvin M. Hotchkiss

Calvin M. Hotchkiss, a Life Fellow of the SMPTE, died October 20, 1988, at the age of 67. Hotchkiss was employed by Eastman Kodak Co. for 30 years in the motion-picture film department. While at Kodak, Hotchkiss assisted many East-coast motion-picture labs and television stations to set up black-and-white and color motion-picture processes. He also instructed lab technicians in printing, processing, and quality control.

He joined the Society in 1951 and found time to serve generously, despite the fact that he spent several years commuting from his home in Philadelphia to his office in New York City. He was Chairman of the Board of Editors from 1982 to 1985; SMPTE Governor, 1978-1979; Chairman of the New York Section in 1975; Secretary/Treasurer of the New York Section, 1974; New York Section Manager, 1972-1973; Chairman of the Committee on Nomenclature, 1951-1954; Registration Chairman for the 118th Technical Conference; Associate Program Chairman for the 114th Technical Conference; and Program Chairman for the 110th Technical Conference.

Julian Z. Millar, a Life Member of the Society, died in April 1988. Millar joined the SMPTE in 1957, while employed by Western Union Telegraph Co. At that time, Millar was part of the development and research staff working on television transmission systems. In addition to his long involvement with the SMPTE, Millar also was a Fellow of the Radio Club of America.

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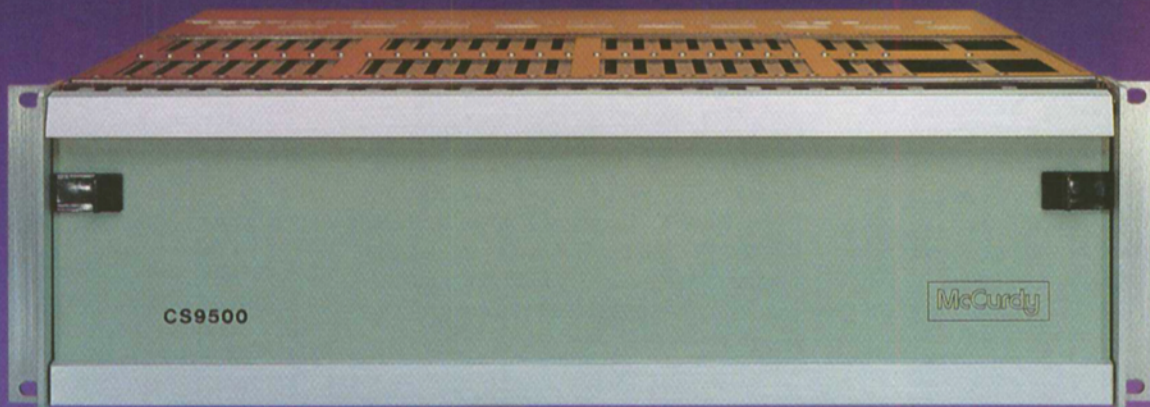
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
