

131st SMPTE Technical Conference and Exhibit

October 21–25, 1989, Los Angeles

The 131st Technical Conference and Equipment Exhibit of the Society of Motion Picture and Television Engineers will be held October 21-25, 1989, at the Los Angeles Convention Center in California.

Engineers from all over the world are expected to attend this conference, which provides an annual forum for discussions and demonstrations on advanced motion-picture and television technology.

SMPTE Editorial Vice-President Frank J. Haney, Capital Cities/ABC, Inc., has appointed John L. Baptista, of Consolidated Film Industries, the Program Chair, and Alan S. Godber, of NBC, the Program Vice-Chair. The theme for the 131st conference, according to Baptista, is "Tradition and Technology — Partners in Progress." This year the Technical Conference will also commemorate the 100th anniversary of the 35mm film format. Those wishing to contribute papers are requested to submit an Author Form, which is available from SMPTE Headquarters, Marilyn Waldman, 595 W. Hartsdale Ave., White Plains, NY 10607, and a 100-word abstract of the proposed paper. This material must be received by June 15, 1989.

Manuscripts chosen for the program will be preprinted and sold at the conference. They will also be considered for publication in the *SMPTE*

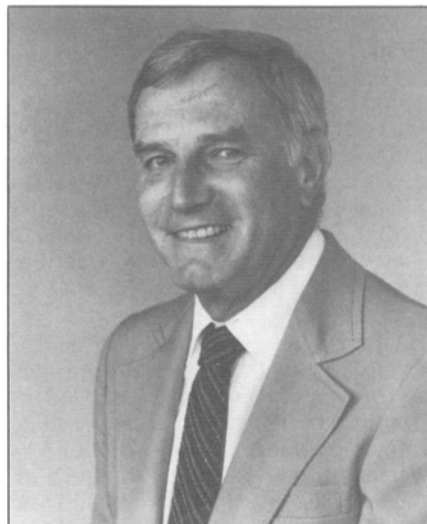
Journal. Papers will be accepted from SMPTE members and non-members alike. Presentations are normally 25 to 35 minutes long and may be supplemented by audiovisuals.

In addition to the technical program, there will be an equipment exhibit and a full schedule of activities. Conference Vice-President Foster Roizen, Telegen, has appointed Howard T. La Zare, Deluxe Laboratories, Inc., to the post of General Arrangements Chair. La Zare is responsible for all non-program activi-

ties. A Welcoming Reception, Banquet, Fellows Luncheon, and Honors and Awards Luncheon will be highlights of the conference. There will also be a Spouses Program and a Coffee Club.

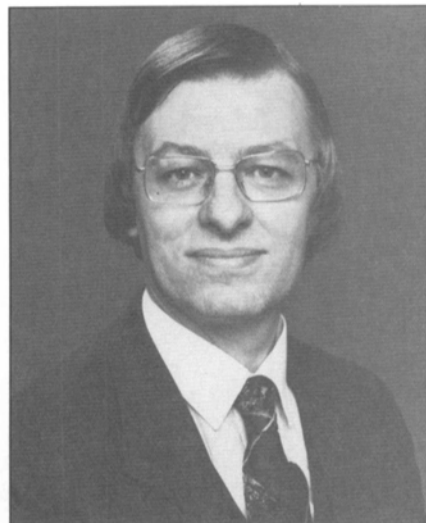

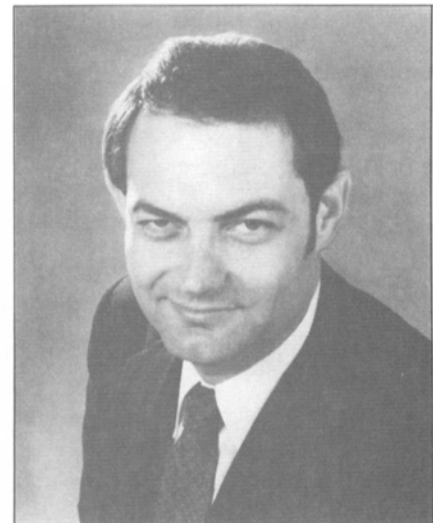
