## Call for Papers

# The 132nd SMPTE Technical Conference and Equipment Exhibit

October 13–17, New York City

A Call for Papers for the SMPTE's 132nd Technical Conference and Equipment Exhibit has been issued by Editorial Vice-President Frank J. Haney (Capital Cities/ABC) and Program Chairman Kerns Powers (consultant).

"Film and Television — One World? has been selected as the theme for this year's conference," said Haney. "We chose that theme because it recognizes the ongoing convergence of these two technologies by providing a forum for their mutual relationships."

For a technical paper to be considered for the program, authors should send their name, company affiliation, address, telephone number, and a 500-word synopsis to SMPTE, Attn: Marilyn Waldman, Program Coordinator, 595 W. Hartsdale Ave., White Plains, NY 10607, by June 15. The information should be submitted on forms which are available from headquarters.

Authors will be notified of acceptance of their papers prior to August 3. Finished manuscripts of accepted

papers are due at Society headquarters by August 13. They will be pre-printed and sold at the conference and will also be considered for publication in the *SMPTE Journal*. SMPTE members and nonmembers alike may present papers. Presentations usually last about 20 minutes.

### Committee Chairmen Appointed

Several committee chairs have already been announced. John L. Baptista (Consolidated Film Industries) and Alan Godber (NBC) have been named program vice-chairmen. Conference Vice-President L. John Erwin (Eastman Kodak Co.) has been appointed to coordinate the film papers and Patricia Spicer will serve as chairwoman of the Spouses Program.

### Equipment Exhibit

The equipment exhibit will run from October 13 to 16. Exhibitor applications have been sent out and should be returned to SMPTE headquarters by May 25, 1990, when the booth-assignment process begins. Booth space will be granted on a priority point system. Approximately 190,000 sq. ft. is available at the Jacob Javits Convention Center for equipment exhibits.

### Other Activities

In addition to the technical program and equipment exhibit, other events will be offered as part of the conference, including an Honors and Awards Luncheon on Saturday, October 13, at the Convention Center; a Fellows Luncheon on Sunday, October 14, at the Marriott Marquis, which will serve as the headquarters hotel; and a banquet on Tuesday, October 16, at the hotel. The *Journal* will continue to publish updates as news develops.
