

The SMPTE Lou Wolf Memorial Scholarship

Applications are now being accepted for the 2003 Lou Wolf Memorial Scholarship for Undergraduate & Graduate Studies in Motion Pictures & Television with an Emphasis on Technology

GOALS AND OBJECTIVES: The Lou Wolf Memorial Scholarship is designed to help students further their undergraduate or graduate studies in motion pictures and television, with an emphasis on technology. SMPTE is the leading technical society for the motion imaging industry, with members spread throughout 85 countries.

ELIGIBILITY: Applicants must be: (1) fulltime students enrolled in an accredited high school, 2 year or 4 year college or university, and (2) current members of SMPTE. For a list of student chapters, see the SMPTE website at www.smpte.org/sections_chapters/. Student membership in SMPTE is available for \$35 per year; for more information see www.smpte.org/membership/individual/join_now/.

AMOUNT OF AWARD: The amount of the award will be up to \$2,000. Awards will be announced by July 30, 2003. Each award will be paid to the accredited educational institution the scholarship winner is attending. In addition, the award includes full conference registration to the 2003 SMPTE Technical Conference and Exhibition, to be held in New York City, in November. Scholarship winners will be recognized at the Honors and Awards Reception during the Conference.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS: Applicants must submit the following items:

1. Applicant's name, address, telephone number, and e-mail address.
2. Current official transcript (grade report).
3. Personal statement of work experience and/or interests that are relevant to the application.
4. Personal statement of goals and objectives of study. This statement should explain the reasons why the Applicant wishes to pursue studies in motion pictures and television with an emphasis on technology, and must be signed by the Applicant.
5. Personal statement of proposed use of funds. Funds may be applied toward tuition, books, supplies, and/or equipment that will further the Applicant's studies.
6. Two (2) letters of recommendation from responsible persons, citing the specific reasons why the Recommender believes the Applicant is deserving of the Award. The letter of recommendation must be signed and dated and must include the Recommender's name, title, address, telephone number, and e-mail address. One letter of recommendation must come from a SMPTE student chapter advisor or a Governor of SMPTE. Applicants who are not attending institutions where a student chapter is located may find a list of Governors in their region in the monthly *SMPTE Motion Imaging Journal* or at www.smpte.org/contact_us/index.cfm?area=governors.
