

2006 Lou Wolf Memorial Scholarship



GOALS AND OBJECTIVES:

The Lou Wolf Memorial Scholarship is designed to help students further their undergraduate or graduate studies in motion pictures and television, with an emphasis on technology. The Society of Motion Picture and Television Engineers (SMPTE) is the leading technical society for the motion imaging industry, with professionals spread worldwide.

ELIGIBILITY:

Applicants must be: (1) fulltime students enrolled in an accredited high school, 2-year or 4-year college or university, and (2) current members of SMPTE. Student membership in SMPTE is available for \$35 per year; for more information go to <http://www.smpte.org/students/membership.cfm>.

AMOUNT OF AWARD:

The amount of the award will be up to \$2,000. Awards will be announced by September 1, 2006. Each award will be paid to the accredited educational institution the scholarship winner is attending. In addition, the award includes full conference registration to the 2006 SMPTE Technical Conference in Hollywood. Scholarship winners will be recognized at the Honors and Awards Ceremony during the Conference.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

Applicants must submit this page, along with the following:

1. Current official transcript (grade report).
2. Personal statement of work experience and/or interests that are relevant to the application.
3. Personal statement of goals and objectives of study. This statement should explain the reasons why the applicant wishes to pursue studies in motion pictures & television with an emphasis on technology, and must be signed by the Applicant.
4. Personal statement of proposed use of funds. Funds may be applied toward tuition, books, supplies, and/or equipment that will further the Applicant's studies.
5. Two (2) letters of recommendation from responsible persons, citing the specific reasons why the Recommender believes the Applicant is deserving of the Award. The letter of recommendation must be signed and dated and must include the Recommender's name, title, address, telephone number, and e-mail address. One letter of recommendation must come from a SMPTE student chapter advisor or a Governor of SMPTE.

Applicants who are not attending institutions where a student chapter is located may find a list of Governors in their region in the front of the *SMPTE Motion Imaging Journal*.
