Re: November/December 2012 *Journal*, "Tutorial on Critical Listening of Multichannel Codec Performance," S. Bharitkar, G. Davidson, L. Fielder, and P. Crum, pp. 30-45.

The authors would like to thank Tomlinson Holman of Apple Inc. for bringing to their attention a correction regarding directivity index (DI) on pp. 34. Specifically, the DI as given in the ITU-R Recommendation BS.1116 is bounded by 6 dB and 12 dB in the frequency domain of interest (500 Hz through 10 kHz). Furthermore, there is an additional requirement that the DI increase smoothly with frequency. Accordingly, the statements in the article "The criterion is that DI should range between 0 and 12 dB and be constant for the frequency range of 40 Hz to 10 kHz," and "Because loudspeakers generally have $DI = 0$ at 40 Hz, the requirement for DI uniformity implies the use of a very omnidirectional loudspeaker." stand corrected.
