Festival entries must fit into one of six award categories:

-  • Best creative use of entertainment technology to engage the audience in the story - (5 minutes)
-  • Best creative use of entertainment technology to engage the audience in the story - (30 seconds)
-  • Best portrayal of entertainment technology in the film - (5 minutes)
-  • Best portrayal of entertainment technology in the film - (30 seconds)
-  • Best use of virtual reality in storytelling
-  • Best use of mobile device or tablet to convey a story
